



# Minute Paper

The Minute Paper is a quick and informal way to assess student comprehension on a lecture or lesson.

## Benefits:

- Can be used as formative feedback
- Can be used to contextualize content
- Can be used as formative assessment
- Can be used to introduce a new topic
- Can be used to identify prior knowledge

- Have students take out a sheet of paper
- Ask the question
- Provide 1 minute to write question response
- Collect responses
